## Tips to Reduce Distractions and Interruptions from Leslie Walden and Barbara Mays



### Culprit #1: The Phone

- Do not answer calls from unrecognized phone numbers. Let go to voice mail.
- Designate specific times to return calls and block them out on your calendar.
- Schedule call times with clients and colleagues (just like a meeting). It's OK to negotiate when is it convenient for me to call you? (Note: Be sure and call when you say you will.)
- Leave detailed phone messages to avoid return calls with questions.
- Tell caller at beginning of conversation if time is not convenient, and give them a choice: short or reschedule.
- Keep your calls brief.

### Culprit #2: Email

- Disable the automatic notifications of email messages (ding, pop up window).
- Complete a project first thing in the morning before looking at email.

### Culprit #3: Uninvited Visitors

- Avoid eye contact when others walk by your desk.
- Post a sign on the door working on an important project.

#### Culprit #4: Our Mind Wanders From the Task at Hand

- Use a timer. Know *exactly* how long you will be working.
- Do not get up unless it is necessary.
- Have all your supplies and tools ready before starting.
- Clear space to spread out (it will also minimize distractions).
- If you find your mind wandering, STOP! Go back to what you were doing or thinking.
- Jot a quick note so you don't forget the thought.
- Keep the work completion time in mind. Knowing how long a project will take will help you stay focused.
